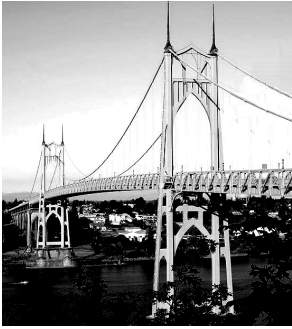




**INTERNATIONAL DRIVE YOUR STUDEBAKER DAY

Saturday, September 8, 2018 is International Drive Your Studebaker Day. This year, the Northwest Chapter members will display their Studebaker cars and trucks to the citizens of Portland by driving them on the streets, on the bridges and in the tunnels within the city.

We will gather in the parking lot at the Fred Meyer Gateway Store, NE 102<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and Halsey Street at 9:30 am for a morning snack and a drivers meeting. Tour Leader, Bob Williams, will distribute illustrated, color printed driving instructions that include topical information about the bridges and tunnels that we will visit. The Tour will depart for the day's festivities at 10:00 am sharp. Before you arrive at the gathering point, be sure you have enough gasoline in your tank to drive about 50 miles and then have enough to get home.

We will have a mid-day lunch break at a location where you will have a selection of at least ten restaurants. The Tour will end between 2:00 and 3:00 pm.

We will drive over the Prettiest Bridge in Portland and over the Ugliest Bridge. We will drive over the bridge with the longest span and the bridge with the shortest span. We will drive over Portland's oldest bridge and newest bridge. We will drive over the tallest bridge and the shortest bridge. And, while we're doing that we'll drive through most, if not all, of Portland's seven tunnels.

So, shine up your Studebaker, bring your camera and be prepared to wave at the Portland natives when they swivel their heads as we drive by.
